5. COVID-19 HEALTH & SAFETY

A. U SPORTS COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement

Prior to arrival at any U SPORTS National Championship event (inclusive of any ancillary events) all participants (student-athletes, coaches, team support staff, athletic therapists/team medical staff, officials, event staff, technical delegates, event medical staff and travelling team delegates) must either:

- Be fully vaccinated (14 days after their second dose of a two-dose, or their only dose of a one-dose, Health Canada approved COVID-19 vaccine series);
OR
- Provide a valid basis for an accommodation (i.e., a reason which falls within a protected ground of discrimination under applicable human rights legislation) that is approved by the participant's institution and the host institution

10. MEDICAL SERVICES

The **Bison Athletic Therapy Centre** is located in room 220 of the Investors Group Athletic Centre.

The clinic will be available for visiting team certified therapists to treat their athletes upon arrival and throughout the duration of the tournament. Arrangements can be made for certified therapists to access the clinic; bookings will occur on a first come first serve basis as there is limited space.

Teams traveling without a certified therapist will be granted access to the clinic based on pre-booked appointment times only (Regular treatment fees apply).

The clinic is equipped with 9 treatment tables, 4 combo modality machines, 3 hydrotherapy tubs, an ice machine and hydrocollator as well as various rehabilitation tools.

Medical coverage

Our host medical staff (certified athletic therapist and athletic therapy certification candidates) will be on site during the championship. A sports medicine physician will also be on-call. Appointments with the sports medicine physician must be made through the certified athletic therapist.

Practices - a host student therapist will be present on site to assist with any medical inquiries or emergency procedures that may be required for official practices.

Games - a certified athletic therapist will be by the court during all games and they will be in charge of the Emergency Action Plan. This Emergency Action Plan will be reviewed at the medical meeting.

If your team plans to travel without any medical staff, let us know at least a week prior to the event. By doing so, we will be in a better position to fill your needs. Fees will apply if your team requires specific medical coverage from our staff.
