Shoot around time slots will also be available on competition days in Gym 2 and Gym 3 and the Main gym when possible, they will be booked in 60 minute time slots and are based on the game times.

## 5. COVID-19 HEALTH & SAFETY

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### A. U SPORTS COVID-19 Vaccination Requirement

Prior to arrival at any U SPORTS National Championship event (inclusive of any ancillary events) all participants (student-athletes, coaches, team support staff, athletic therapists/team medical staff, officials, event staff, technical delegates, event medical staff and travelling team delegates) must either:

- Be fully vaccinated (14 days after their second dose of a two-dose, or their only dose of a one-dose, Health Canada approved COVID-19 vaccine series); **OR**
- Provide a visiting university-approved exemption pursuant to the Ontario *Human Rights Code*. Individuals with a visiting university-approved exemption must comply with rapid antigen or PCR testing requirements as per [OUA policy](#).

### Masking:

As per Queen's University policy, spectators are required to use **ASTM Level 2 medical-grade masks** (or better) while attending any Queen's competition and/or entry to any facility (on / off campus) used for Queen's sanctioned activities.
