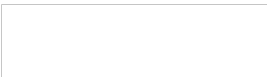

3. TEAM CANADA TRAVEL & INSURANCE

A. VISAS

All participants of the 2019 Winter Universiade (athletes, team officials, mission staff / support) will have the right to enter/exit the territory of the Russian Federation under a **visa-free** regime on the basis of the **Accreditation Certificate** issued by the Organizing Committee free of charge.

The Accreditation Certificate is an official document containing personal data and a photo. The Accreditation Certificate will be valid from February 22 to March 19, 2019.

Accreditation Certificates will be provided to all individuals in the FISU accreditation system by the deadline date. Information regarding the accreditation process will be provided in November via email. Prior to this please start to consider the following, as each participant will require the following documents:

- A passport valid for at least 6 months after the expiry date of the Accreditation Certificate (ie. Expiry date Sept.19, 2019)
- Academic Eligibility Form
- Headshot

Once provided with the Accreditation Certificate travellers will be required to show their passport (with a valid 6 month expiry date) and the printed copy of electronic form of Accreditation Certificate at the passport control in Russia.

B. FLIGHTS

For NSOs and / or individuals booking their own flights please ensure you book as early as possible to avoid an increase in flight costs. *(Quote as of October 24, 2018 \$904.81excluding taxes from Toronto Feb.26-Mar.14)*

Note: Athletes and coaches must check out of their accommodations within 36 hours of their sport's final event.
