This 160,000 plus-square-foot facility is conveniently located on the campus of UPEI and has become a lead hosting venue of World, National and Provincial tournaments with the distinction of being the most active recreational facility on Prince Edward Island and features one of the most functional recreational setups in Atlantic Canada with two official NHL sized ice pads (200 x 85) inside MacLauchlan Arena, a 25-meter 8 lane competition pool, leisure and toddler pool, hot tub, accessible change rooms, waterslide and diving boards. The complex has 4 community rooms including a board room, 2 multi-use rooms and two fully licensed hospitality suites.
